ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Staff Sergeant Kyser Clark distinguished himself by meritorious service as Client Systems Technician, Network Operations, 732d Air Mobility Squadron, Joint Base Elmendorf-Richardson, Alaska. During this period, Sergeant Clark showcased outstanding leadership skills as an alternate vehicle program manager. While coordinating with the Logistics Readiness Squadron, Maintenance and Air Transportation Flights, he resolved 14 issues and safeguarded 86 Squadron vehicle assets. Additionally, he demonstrated superb attention to detail while validating 142 user accounts and identifying 96 errors during an annual network user inspection. His efforts bolstered security while enabling 1,500 Air Mobility Command missions. Furthermore, Sergeant Clark implemented 1,500 object updates while directing a non-compliance tasking order. By collaborating with the local Cyber Operations Squadron, he eliminated a major threat and averted degradation of a 55-million-dollar network. Finally, his immediate response to six classified message incidents proved vital when he expertly sanitized secret data leaks in 40 systems and 17 servers. His actions assured the flying operations for a remarkable 15,600 sorties flown in just a three-year period. The distinctive accomplishments of Sergeant Clark reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.

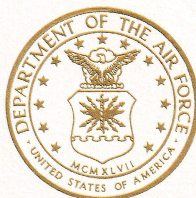
