ACCOMPLISHMENTS

Senior Airman Kyser J. Clark distinguished himself by meritorious service as Communications Focal Point Technician, 8th Communications Squadron, 8th Mission Support Group, 8th Fighter Wing, Kunsan Air Base, Republic of Korea. During this period, Airman Clark coordinated communications focal point helpdesk workflow by synchronizing seven sections and completing five thousand trouble tickets in sustaining eight thousand network devices. His efforts equipped thirty-one hundred joint service personnel with access to a fifty-five million dollar telecommunications network. Additionally, Airman Clark was an Emergency Management Support member, where he traversed fifteen zones shielding Kunsan Air Base from chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and explosive threats. His vigilant patrols contributed to defending forty-three F-16 aircraft, the flight line infrastructure, and furthered the North Korean nuclear deterrence mission. Finally, Airman Clark expedited the Global Video Service installation, by seamlessly configuring application profiles with proprietary user devices. His labors facilitated weekly strategic public health conferences and disease mitigation efforts during a pandemic for fifty-one geographically separated senior leaders. The distinctive accomplishments of Airman Clark reflect credit upon himself and the United States Air Force.
